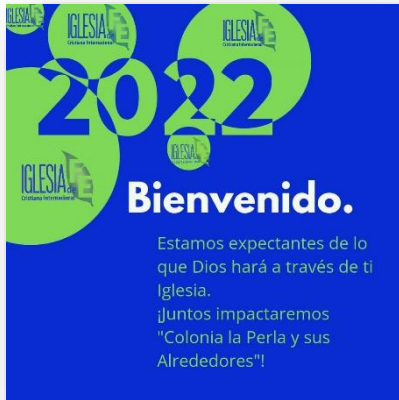


Ministerial Report Iglesia de Fe Guadalajara Mexico

The Way Ministries Guadalajara:

Through this report we want to let you know the great support and sustenance that you have been for this Church, because together we have managed to expand the Kingdom of God in the "La Perla" Community.



Observing the year that has passed shows us God's faithfulness to his people.

We started this year 2022 with a word that God showed us "Be Intentional". Intentional in making known the truth of Jesus Christ at every opportunity that the Lord puts in our path.

And there really were many opportunities that God opened this 2022...

During this year God made it possible for each week of the 12 months to cook food for 100 people, preach the gospel and have the opportunity to pray for requests. It has been great to see the streets of a hospital turned into a small Church, where the presence of God breaks the hearts of the people who have spent hours or perhaps a few days waiting for a diagnosis of the patients in the Hospital. As a testimony Ilse and her son Dilan are members of Iglesia de Fe and they are a fruit of this ministry.



God gave us the opportunity to carry out 5 evangelistic events with the aim of blessing the La Perla Community and being able to get closer to people.

One of them "Divertifin Grúas y Concreto" was directed by the missionary group sent by our Mother Church Faith Church Kentucky. We never imagined how the Church would be transformed into a construction stage, the children had so much fun and it was great to see both churches work together. It is through this ministry that Rafael and his 8-year-old son Elias began to attend Church; they live 8 blocks from the building where we are.



Another event that took place was the Finance workshop given by Pastor Mark. It was a great blessing to see how, to this day, many of the participants put into practice each of the aforementioned tips.



With the support of "The Way Ministries" an intensive English course was carried out where we had the participation of adults and children. How the fruit of this ministry Rosa and her daughter Cesi began to attend Church.



This event together with the Gelatinas workshop were carried out with the objective of giving people in the community tools for a source of income.

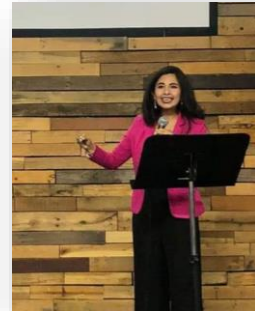
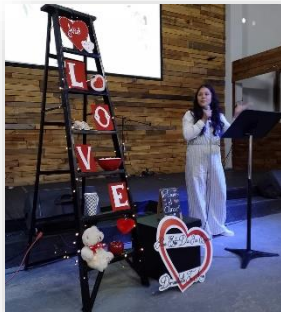


Through the intensive dance course that was carried out during the summer vacations by the secondary school of YWAM San Jose Costa Rica Dance God opened doors to visit the prison for men and women, we were able to bless the lives of the inmates with donations of toilet paper, soap, and diapers.

We also had the opportunity for some of the members of the Church and people from the community to present a recital of the choreographies learned during the course.



Since the beginning of the year God had shown a more effective work plan for the women's ministry "Created for God" and we decided in our hearts to schedule a monthly meeting to follow up on the spiritual growth of the women of the Church, it was great to see how this plan was carried out, we gave the opportunity for some of the women of the Church to preach in some services with the aim of promoting their leadership and study of the Bible.



We prayed for workers and God added to our Church a missionary couple who began to work full time with us in September, Alan and Patricia.



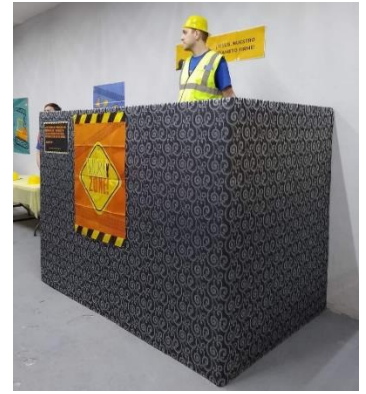
In the same way, this year the Intercession ministry was opened and every Thursday via Zoom we have a special time to pray for requests from the members of our Church; as well as by other Ministries or Churches.



We were able to make some improvements and remodeling to the Church facilities, which include:

- * Making the kitchen area more functional.
- *Painting the floors of our auditorium.
- *Installing of sound and multimedia booth.
- *Creating rooms with bunk beds to receive groups.
- *Floorboard for stage.





This last month of the year we were able to deliver 150 blankets to the homeless who are around Comunidad La Perla; 10 Christmas Baskets were also delivered to families with whom we have been sharing the gospel throughout the year.



This coming Monday December 19th we will have a second visit to the jail where we will have the opportunity to share true freedom to those who are physically captive, and be able to bless them with blankets and some personal hygiene items.

It has been a long journey, but without your prayers and support we would not have made it. Thank you for being obedient to God's call and being a church together with us no matter how far away we are.

Let's keep going by being intentional all the time sharing about Jesus!

It will be a great blessing to continue working together this coming 2023.
